**ORDER**

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Government approved the Prospectus for Admission to Professional Degree Courses for the year 2020 (KEAM ). As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Principal, Markaz Unani Medical College and Hospital , Kozhikode had requested to grant permission to admit the NEET qualified students from other states ( Non-Keralite II), if seats remain vacant for BUMS Course after admission of the students from Kerala and Non-Keralite (I) Category.

2.The Clause 6.1(iii) of 2020 KEAM Prospectus, the criteria of Eligibility for admission for Non- Keralite category states:

*"Non-Keralite Category II (NK II) candidates are also eligible for admission to both Government and Management quota seats in Private Self-financing Engineering/Architecture/Siddha colleges. But for Siddha course, 'Non-Keralite Category II' (NK II) candidates will be considered only when the Keralite and Non-Keralite I (NK I) candidates are not available for admission."*

3.As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, the Director of Ayurveda Medical Education reported that permission may be granted to consider the NEET qualified students from other states ( Non-Keralite II), if seats remain vacant for BUMS Course after admission of the students from Kerala and Non-Keralite (I) Category, as allowed for Siddha (BSMS) course in Kerala.

4.Government examined the matter in detail and are pleased to grant permission to consider the NEET qualified students from other states ( Non-Keralite II), if seats remain vacant for BUMS Course after admission of the students from Kerala and Non-Keralite (I) Category, as allowed for Siddha (BSMS) course in Kerala and are pleased to amend the Clause 6.1(iii) of the KEAM 2020 Prospectus as detailed below:

The Clause 6.1(iii) :The criteria of Eligibility for admission : Non- Kerallite category : *"Non-Keralite Category II (NK II) candidates are also eligible for admission to both Government and Management quota seats in Private Self-financing Engineering/Architecture/Siddha/Unani colleges. But for Siddha and Unani course, 'Non-Keralite Category II' (NK II) candidates will be considered only when the Keralite and Non-Keralite I (NK I) candidates are not available for admission."*

5. Government Order read above stands modified to the above extent.


